Open Shot

One of the best simple video editors for beginners

- Free video editing software with full editing suite
- Available for Windows, Mac and Linux
- Good for small business because you can:
 - Resize clips
 - Scale (i.e. make something pop from zero to full screen)
 - Trim
 - Snap (which allows you to have clips attach to each other and fit together automatically so there's no gaping image between clips. Very useful!)
 - Rotate
 - Edit Audio
 - Has a Real Time Preview.

Open Shot Features

- Customizable title-card templates
- Drag and drop functionality so you can just drag you audio, video and images into the timeline
- Video Effects
- Available in 70+ Languages
- Keyframe animation which is an advanced editing technique to change size, sound, effects, visuals and animation frame by frame of your video.
 - I will do a video tutorial on audio key framing to show you how to fix pops or sound problems that cannot be fixed with an audio effect.
- Video Effects to remove backgrounds from your videos (green screening), invert colors, adjust brightness, etc.
 - Brightness is important for the marketing video because if the video clip of you talking is too dark, you may be able to brighten it with the brightness effect. That is why many videos where people are talking against a white background seem so bright they are brightly lit but they often have a brightness effect added to them in the postproduction video editing phase. You will be able to use that trade secret with this software.
- Slow Motion and Time Effects with pre-set animations for playback
- Unlimited layers
 - so you can drag one clip over another and use your green screen Done For You Clips
 - You can put a title another clip
 - Can add audio (music and sound effects like a pop) underneath a video clips

Full Editing Suite for Windows (professional version also available)

- Free video editing software with full editing suite
- Available for Windows, Mac and Linux
- Good for small business
- You can:
 - resize clips
 - scale (which is make something bigger or smaller, which you may want to do if you want your face to fill up more of the screen, you can scale the video clip so it's bigger)
 - Trim
 - Snap (which allows you to have clips attach to each other and fit together automatically so there's no gaping image between clips. Very useful!)
 - Rotate
 - Edit audio
 - Has a real time preview

Apple iMovie Good for Beginners

- Free video editing software with editing suite
- Available for Mac only
- Studio-Quality Titles that allow you to customize the font, size, color and formatting
- 10 Creative Filters
- Pre-set Video Trailer Templates
- Advanced Editing Tools:
 - Fix shaky videos
 - Green screen effects
 - 24 transitions
 - Some background effects like colors, curtains and world maps
 - Cut from iPhone, to iPad to Mac using airdrop
- You can:
 - Record your voice over to clips
 - Add music or sound effects
 - You can trim and cut
 - Add a Ken Burns effect which is movement to a still photo or movie video
 - Change to Black and White or Sepia
 - They do not support plug-ins so there are limitations to what you can do

- You can use the Professional Marketing Video Structure Model to Begin Creating Your Project, dragging and dropping titles and clips for each sequence of your video, layering the different videos and music, using the actor on a stage analogy.
- You'll be able to import and drag and drop Done For You Clips into your software.
- Download the Free App Handbrake so that you can convert large movie files to smaller files for uploading to websites and the internet.

Sample Easy Editing Using Your Editing Software

- Create a Project
- Import Files or Drag Files into your Editing Timeline
 - Done For You Clips
 - Your Magical Video Piece
 - Stock Footage
 - Royalty Free Music
- Start Editing
- Trim, Cut, Lengthen
- Apply Effects and Transitions
 - Do that after the music is in remember below all of the video and title clips like the orchestra below the stage
- Clean up sound and apply brighten effects to your videos so it looks professional
- If you are using Final Cut Pro X, you will have an opportunity to import the title, effects and generator plugins I list for you in a separate tool in the next session.
- Get creative.
- Choose your titles.
- Choose your color scheme and stick to a few colors for titles so that it is consistent throughout the video.
